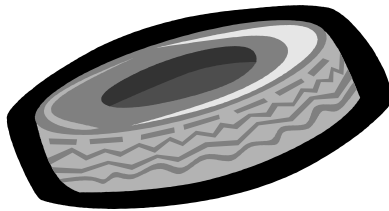

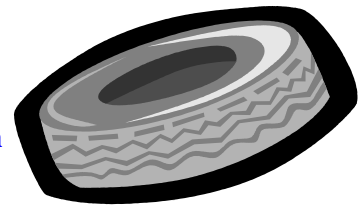
COMING TO A SCHOOL NEAR YOU!
