High School Programming

The planetarium can be used to supplement instruction across many disciplines. The following are a few examples.

Astronomy: Use the planetarium as your outdoor lab for many concepts.

Biology: Astrobiology studies can range from life in our solar system to the search for life on extra solar planets.

Chemistry: Nucleosynthesis and identification of elements in stars.

Literature: Homer's Odyssey.

Math: Celestial navigation; coordinate systems.

Physics: Light, color and optics.

ROTC: Map and GPS use.

Science and Social studies: map and globe studies; seasons and weather; solar system; earth motions and time; the early explorers like Lewis and Clark.
